- Proof of skills in English (an internationally recognised test, e.g. IELTS / TOEFL or equivalent)
- For European students: copy of the European Health Insurance student card
- For non-European students: copy, in English, of the insurance coverage plan mentioning the repatriation option
- Handicap form if necessary

# What language level is required to come and study at ISC

- TOEFL IBT test minimum score: 79/120 points • TOEFL ITP test minimum score: 543/677 points
- TOEIC test minimum score: 785/990 points • IELTS test minimum score: 6.5 points
- O CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, for students who wish to take course taught in French): minimum score B2

#### Transcript of records

Transcripts will be available on the student's account. Original transcripts will be sent to partner's universities upon student's request.

## How can I get to the school?

You can reach ISC Paris easily by public transport: bus (84, 94, 341), tramway (3b), metro (lines 3 and 13) and train (line L from Saint Lazare station)
