The exclusive access to high-level networking activities, events, renowned guest speakers, and institutional partnerships, creates a gateway for future success.



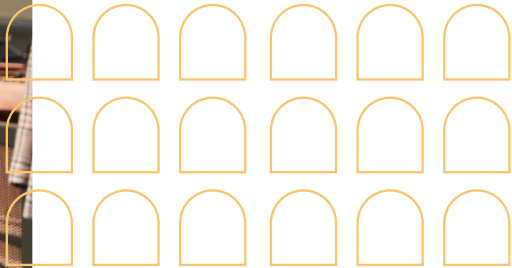
