Baruch COLLEGE WRITING CENTER

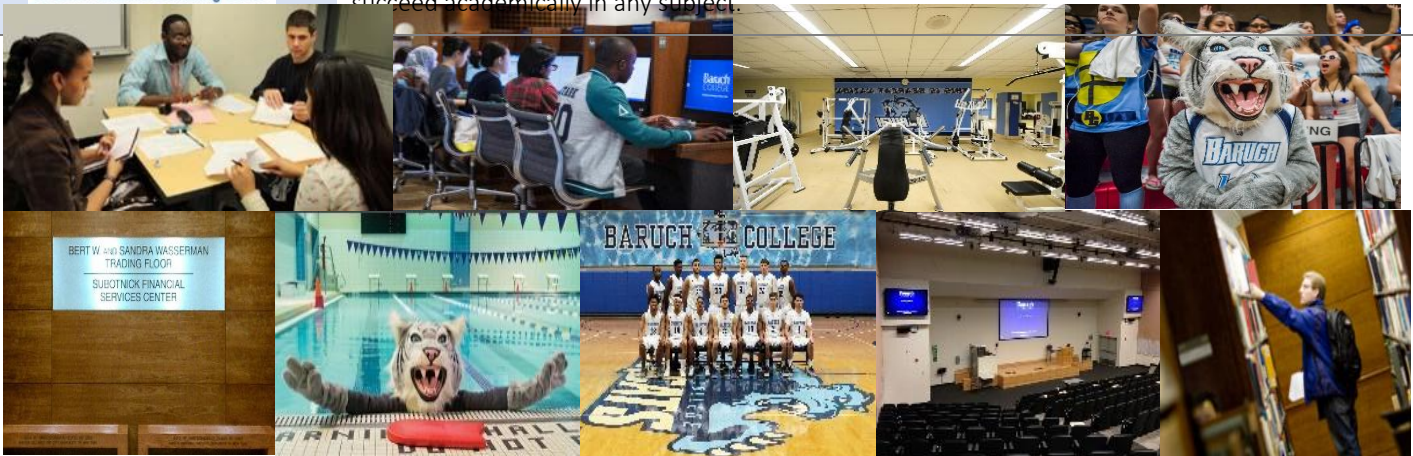

TfCS Tools for Clear Speech

The only program of its kind in the U.S., Tools for Clear Speech is designed to help non-native English speakers improve their oral communication skills. The program offers workshops and one-on-one sessions, small group conversation hours, focused skills series, and oral communication video assessments.

SACC Student Academic Consulting Center

The Student Academic Consulting Center provides tutoring services in most subjects to Baruch students. | Language Requirements | Proficiency in English: Although there is no required minimum score, a TOEFL score of around 90 or IELTS score of 6.5 are the recommended levels of proficiency in the language.
